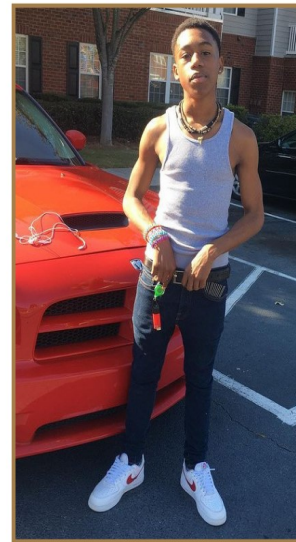

OBITUARY

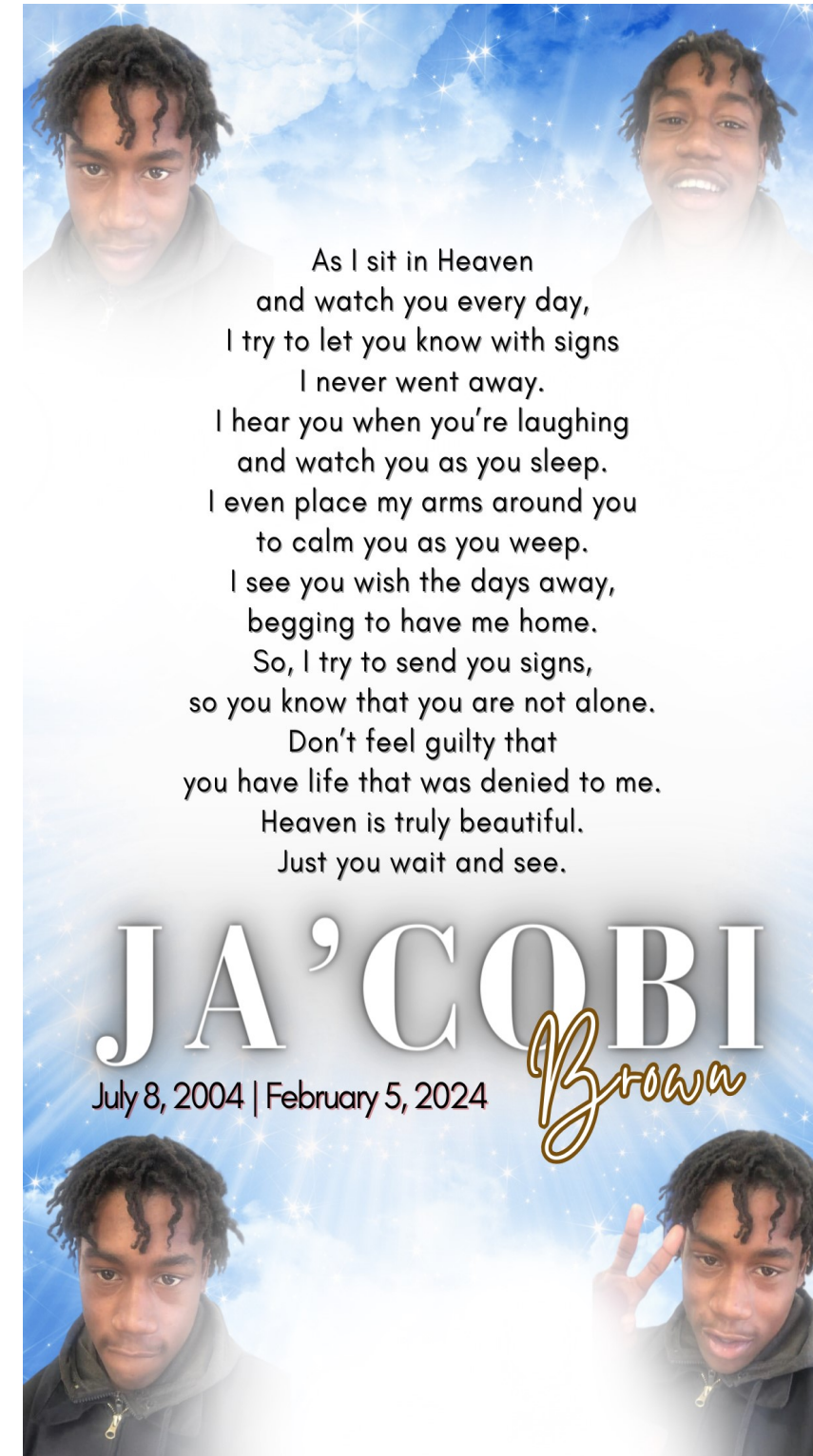
