I am not there. I did not die!*

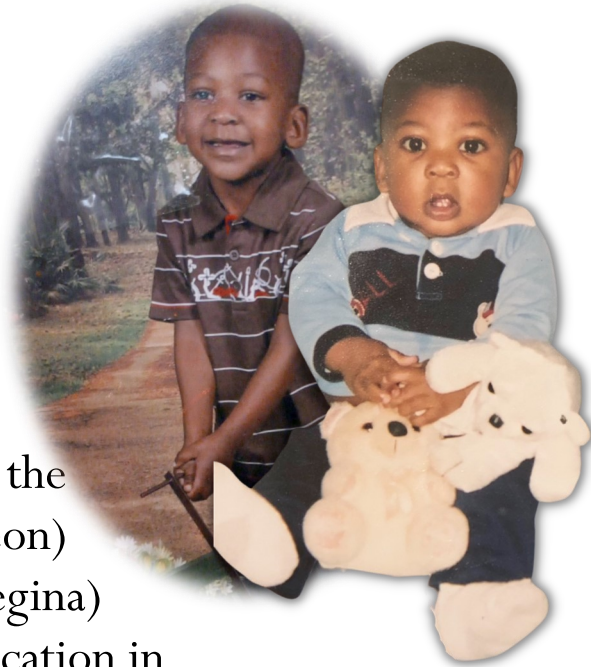
