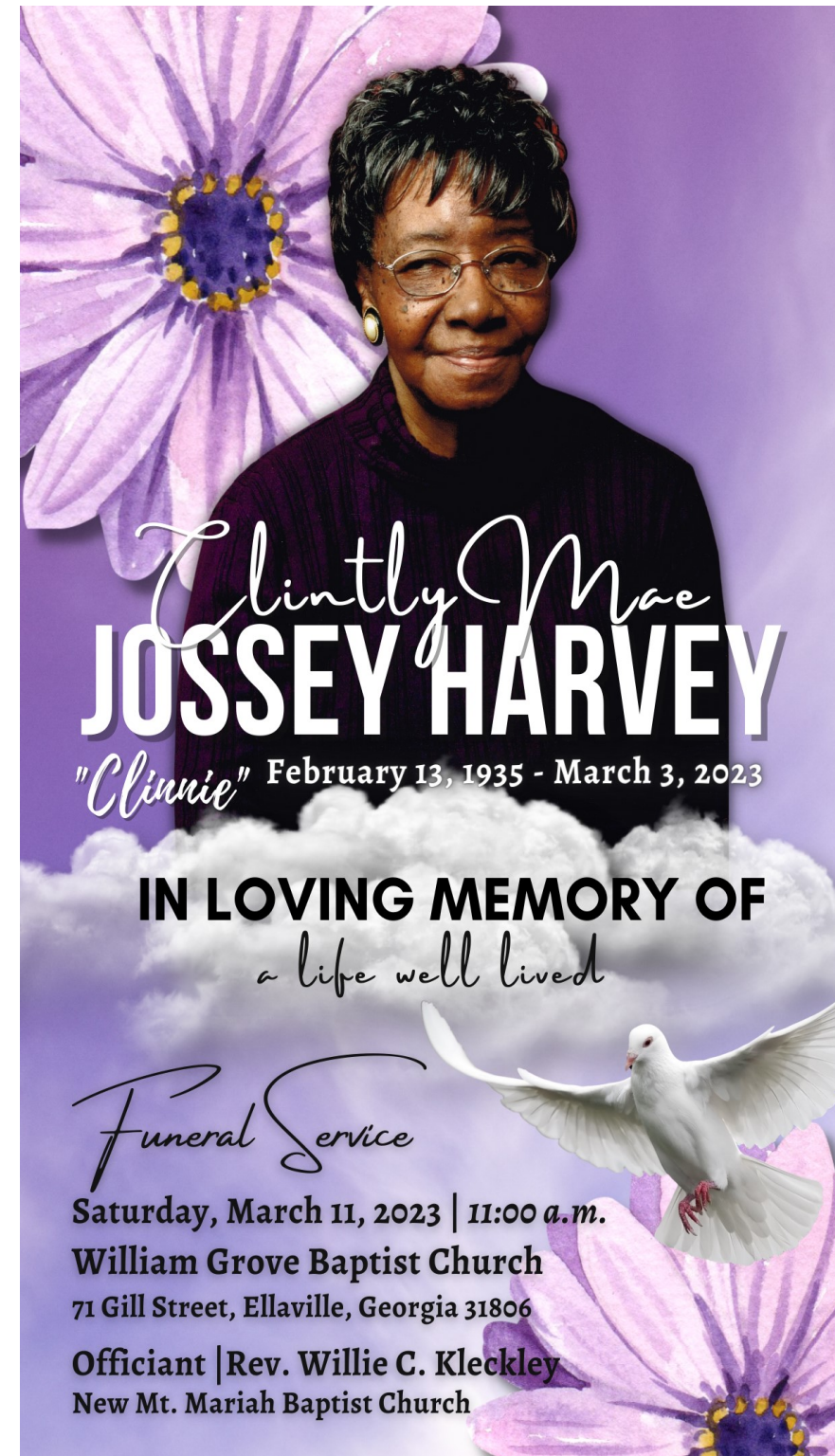

She is preceded in death by her siblings: two brothers and one sister and her son, Kenneth Lee Harvey, Sr.

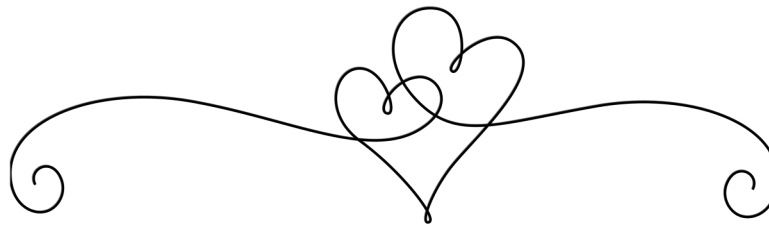
