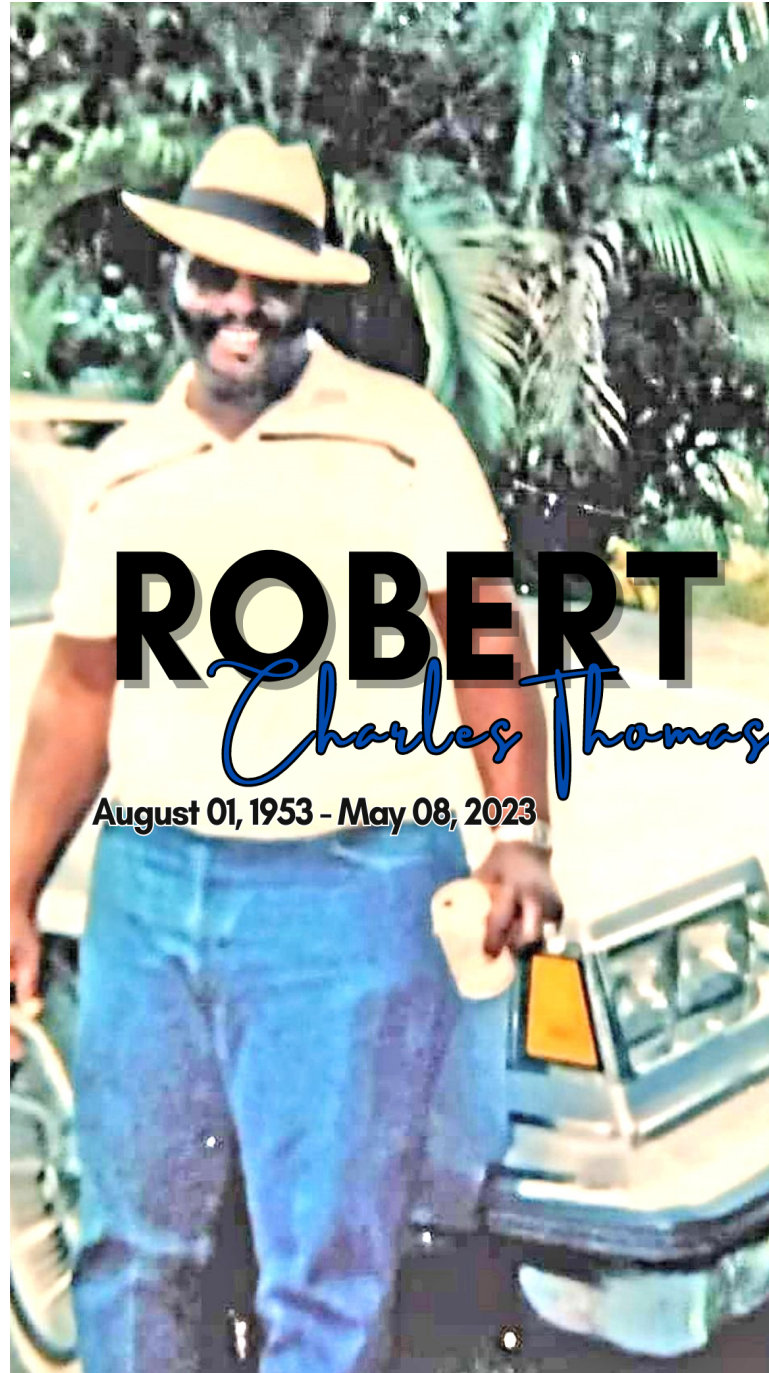
THE LIFE STORY OF
