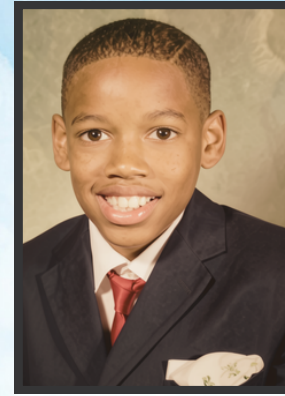

your LOVE helped lift us through it all.

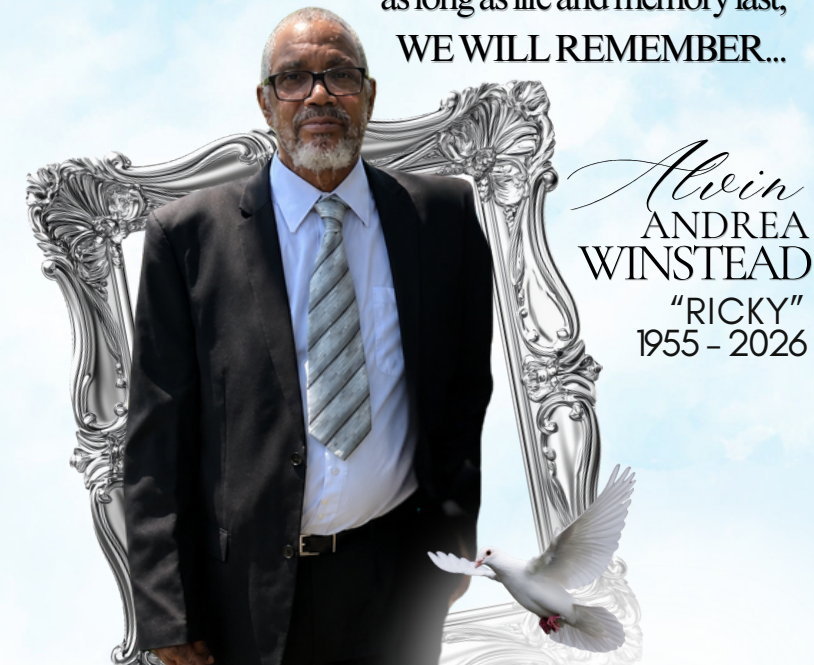
