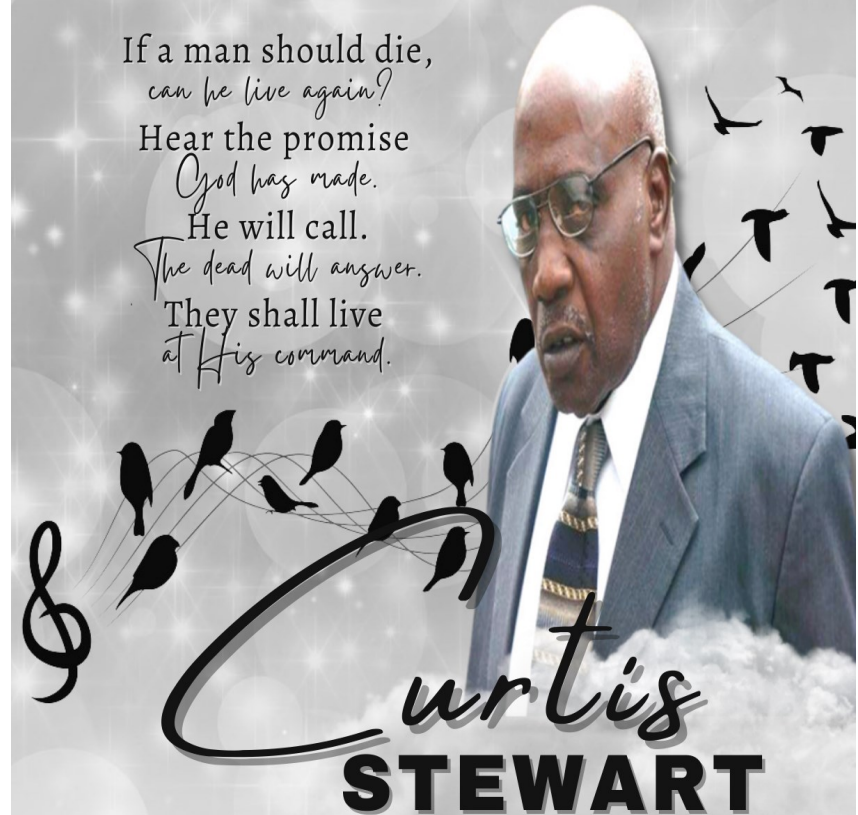

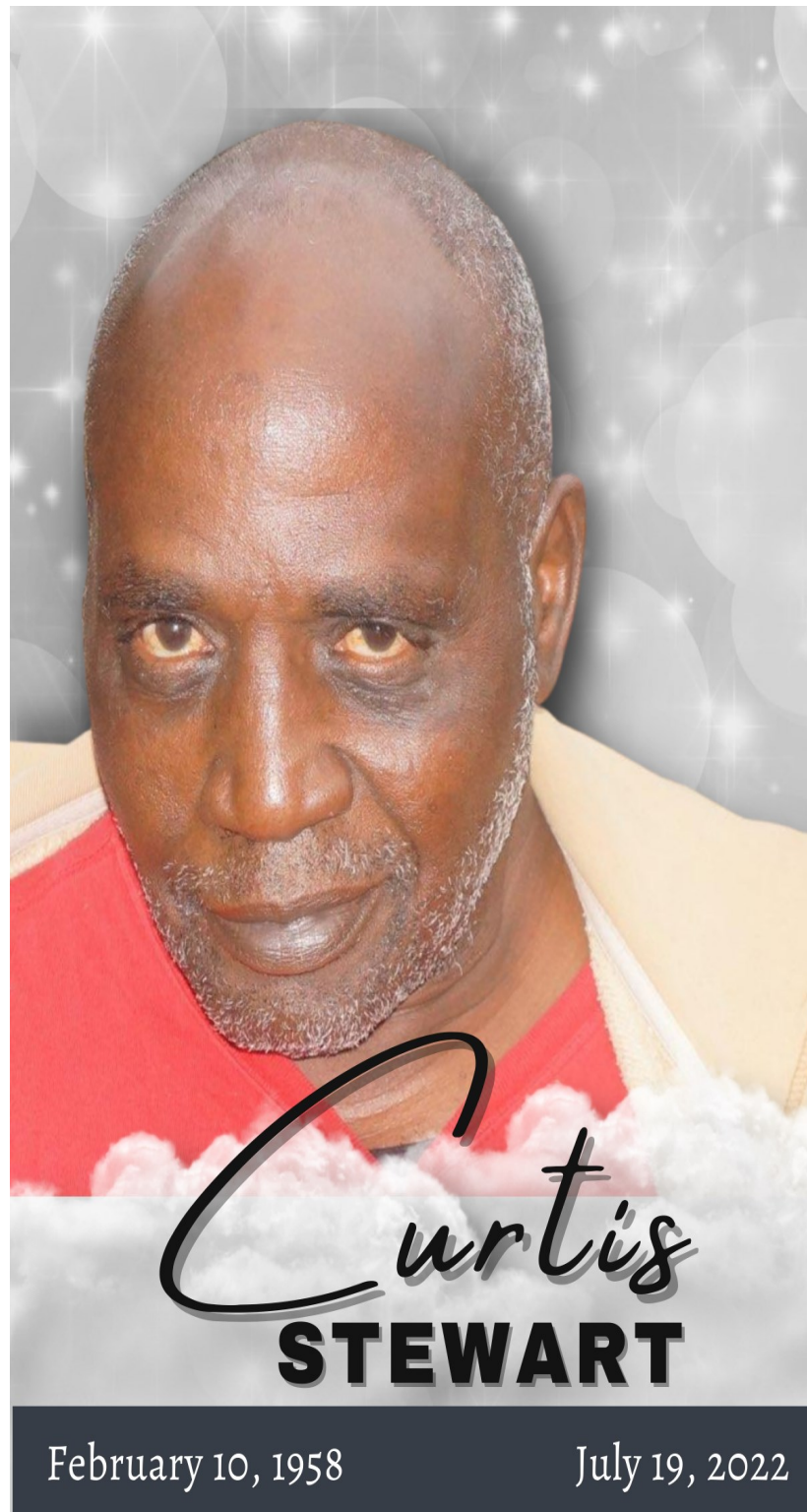
MR. CURTIS STEWART
